TrueSchool's Educator-Innovator-in-Residence (EIR) is a fellowship for current or former educators who seek to hone their student-centered design skills and inspire teams of educators to design new learning models. EIRs support facilitation of in-person Studios and lead virtual coaching during our multi-week program experiences. The position provides a training period in student-centered design and opportunities for travel. EIRs receive quarterly updates from the CEO and serve as strategic advisors as TrueSchool seeks to scale its programs and impact, locally and globally.
